When you arrive at MEGA:

Upon arrival, participants may pick up materials at the registration desk in the Mobile Convention Center Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. each day.

Conference App:

We encourage you to use the **conference app** with features such as the photo album, "connect" tool, "interact" feed, and session discussion tool to interact with presenters, exhibitors, and/or other attendees during the conference.

What to Wear and Bring:

Participants are invited to dress comfortably and may want to consider bringing a sweater or jacket for cooler environments, especially if sensitive to cooler temperatures. Participants should wear their name badge to all MEGA Conference sessions and events and bring their mobile device with the MEGA Conference 2024 app downloaded to it to receive credit for attending sessions.

What to Eat:

As always, breakfast and snacks will be provided for all registered attendees to enjoy in each conference venue Tuesday through Thursday. On Friday, breakfast will be provided at the Mobile Convention Center only. For lunch (on your own), there will be a variety of convenient dining options located within each of the conference venues to accommodate different dietary preferences.

- The Mobile Convention Center will have several food kiosks set up throughout the convention center serving items such as sandwiches, salads, soups, snacks, and drinks. Also, there will be three food trucks in the MCC exhibit hall on the first floor with a variety of options, including Caribbean-infused American Cuisine, cheesesteaks, loaded fries, wings, and tacos.
- The Riverview Renaissance Hotel will offer a daily southern buffet with options such as catfish, fried chicken, and pasta dishes.
- The Battle House Hotel will have a pop-up salad, soup, and sandwich bar and quick options at their in-house restaurant, Joe Cain's.

Where to park:

If not staying and parking at a hotel within walking distance of the Mobile Convention Center, parking (at no cost to MEGA Conference 2024 Attendees) will be available at the Mobile Cruise Terminal, located at 201 S. Water Street. Free air-conditioned shuttle round-trip service will be provided daily at 15-minute intervals from the Cruise Terminal parking lot to the Convention Center from Monday, July 8th through Thursday, July 11th, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and will conclude on Friday, July 12th at noon. Limited parking can also be found in the parking deck under the Mobile Convention Center for \$10 per day.

Shuttle Service:

In addition to shuttle service from the Mobile Cruise Terminal Parking lot to the Convention Center, free airconditioned shuttle round-trip service will also be provided for the Battle House, Admiral, and Downtown Holiday Inn hotels with a designated waiting area. Shuttle Service will run Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and will conclude on Friday, July 12th at noon.
